Dear Sir/Madam,

KDBA has allotted Shuttlers Badminton Academy, Chrompet, to Organize District Sub/Junior Badminton Ranking Tournament -2017 from **13<sup>th</sup>** to **15<sup>th</sup>** January 2017 (3 days). The following are the guidelines.

**1. DATES OF THE TOURNAMENT: 13 (Fri), 14 (Sat) & 15 (Sun) January 2017.**

1.1 The Tournament Schedule is as follows

Release of Draw	<b>11<sup>th</sup> Jan 2017 Wednesday</b>

*\*Previous year KDBA Positions and Ranking shall be considered for this event while preparing seeding report.*

**2. PRIZES & RANKING SYSTEM:**

- 2.1 Prizes, Certificates, Gifts and Badminton Products shall be awarded to the top-4 in all categories.
- 2.2 KDBA Ranking Points shall be calculated and awarded to all players those who reach QF/SF/Finals.
- 2.3 The Ranking Points shall be considered for all future events of KDBA in 2017, henceforth.

### 3. INDIVIDUAL EVENTS:

3.1 The Tournament shall be organized in following age groups in Individual events.

<b>Sub Junior Boys Singles - U-13 (BS-U13)</b>	<b>Sub Junior Girls Singles - U-13 (GS-U13)</b>
<b>Junior Boys Singles - U- 15 (BS-U15)</b>	<b>Junior Girls Singles - U- 15 (GS-U15)</b>
<b>Sub Junior Boys Doubles - U-13 (BD-U13)</b>	<b>Sub Junior Girls Doubles - U-13 (GD-U13)</b>
<b>Junior Boys Doubles - U- 15 (BD-U15)</b>	<b>Junior Girls Doubles - U- 15 (GD-U15)</b>

3.2 The tournament shall be organized in following age groups only having the specified eligibility criteria of date of birth.

3.3 **BAI ID** is highly preferred. In the absence of BAI ID, Scan Copy/Photo of **Original DOB** Certificate is mandatory (upload in [www.where2play.in](http://www.where2play.in)). All other proofs shall not be entertained.

### 4. TOURNAMENT COMMITTEE/LOGISTICS:

4.1 Three (3) members shall be nominated by the Host Academy.

4.2 The Organizing Secretary, Referee and one Representative from KDBA shall form the Tournament Committee.

4.3 The Host Academy shall provide three (3) courts for the tournament, full time

### 5. MODE OF COMPETITION:

5.1 All matches in the main draw up to **QF (Quarter Finals)** shall be played best of three games of 15 points (15 X 3) on rally point system, no extension at 15.

5.2 All the matches in **Semi-Finals (SF)** and **Finals** shall be played best of three games of 21 points on rally point system. (21 X 3)

5.3 Qualifying Rounds (if exists) may have 1 game of 30 points (30 X 1) scoring, on rally point system.

### 6. ENTRIES:

6.1 The Entries shall be accepted ONLY via online with the BAI Id or Date-of-Birth scanned copy in PDF or Image format attachment/upload.

6.2 The procedure for Online-Registration is <http://where2play.in/>

6.3 No Entry shall be accepted over phone or in person in the host academy.

6.4 No entry shall be accepted unless, the player is originally attached to KDBA or if playing for the first-time, shall remain in the KDBA unit, henceforth.

6.5 Once the entries are duly verified, the draws shall be placed in Shuttlers Badminton Academy and circular shall be sent to KDBA for distribution.

6.6 It shall be the responsibility of the Affiliated Academies and the players/Coaches/Parents to ensure that all the entries send by them appear in the Draw. After the Last Date for withdrawals without penalty, no complaints shall be entered for miss out of any entry. The organizing Panel is not responsible for any omissions or correction of names.

6.7 Entries without the remittance of entry fee shall not be entertained/included in the draw.

6.8 → → A Player can register/participate in maximum of Two (2) Events only.

## 7. FEES

7.1 The Fee for the Events shall be as follows:

U13 Singles – Boys & Girls	<b>Rs. 300/-</b> (Rupees Three Hundred Only)
U13 Doubles – Boys & Girls	<b>Rs. 600/-</b> (Rupees Six Hundred Only)
U15 Singles – Boys & Girls	<b>Rs. 400/-</b> (Rupees Four Hundred Only)
U15 Doubles – Boys & Girls	<b>Rs. 800/-</b> (Rupees Eight Hundred Only)
<b>PENALTY:</b> Late fee of <b>Rs. 100/-</b> shall apply for all entries after the deadline & before 5-Jan-2017	
<b>Late Withdrawal :</b> A fee of <b>Rs. 200/-</b> shall apply for every <b>withdrawal</b> beyond the deadline, <b>5<sup>th</sup> Jan</b> Entry Fee shall not be refunded for " <b>No-Show</b> " or for any withdrawals beyond <b>9<sup>th</sup> Jan</b> .	

7.2 Technical **Officials Fee (10% Incl.** in the Entry fee and go towards Technical Officials expenses)

7.3 Please carry the payment confirmation receipt number or screenshot, for any reference.

7.4 All Entries shall be paid **ONLY** via online through - <http://where2play.in/>

7.5 All Entries with a valid payment shall be confirmed and considered for the Draw. No exceptions.

## 8. PROTEST

8.1 The fees for lodging protest of any kind shall be **Rs. 5 0 0 /- (Rupees Five Hundred Only)**. This fee shall be retained by the organizers of the event. Any protest shall be addressed to the Org. Secretary in writing within one hour after completion of the match.

## 9. DRAW

9.1 The Draw shall be done during 9<sup>th</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> January 2016 by the Tournament Referee

9.2 The complete Draw shall be done thru Tournament Planner Software.

9.3 Nature of the Draws either, Knock-Out or Round-Robin, shall be at the discretion of the Referee.

9.4 If the number of entries exceed the allowable limit in any event, there may be Qualifier rounds.

9.5 All applicable standard procedures shall be followed in the draw processes.

9.6 Copy of draw shall be available in the Host academy and electronic copy may be forwarded to all coaches and players concerned (possibly through their WhatsApp number)

## 10. WITHDRAWALS

10.1 If there are any withdrawals notified after the close of entries, the same shall be intimated to KDBA immediately with a copy to the organizers before the closing date of withdrawal.

10.2 **No Show** list of players (who didn't report) shall be submitted to district association.

10.3 Any Player withdraws/retires in an event (Ex. Singles) **SHALL NOT** be allowed to play in any other event (Ex. doubles) throughout the tournament.

## 11. EQUIPMENT & SPONSOR:

11.1 The Equipment Sponsor for this tournament shall be **Kawasaki**

11.2 **Kawasaki** shall provide adequate tubes of shuttles for all the evening, without rationing.

11.3 **Kawasaki** shall place necessary A-boards and banners surrounding the court at their cost.

11.4 **Kawasaki** may have a local stall in the premises for any product promotions during the event.

11.5 **Kawasaki** shall provide Prizes for the top-4 positions in all categories, and some special prizes.

## 12. TECHNICAL OFFICIALS

- 12.1 The Host Organizers shall arrange a qualified Referee and Match Control
- 12.2 Host Organizers shall arrange adequate Umpires, Shuttle Control, and required technical help.
- 12.3 The Host Organizers shall take reasonable efforts to arrange line judges, however line-judges shall be arranged for Semi-Finals & Finals of all categories.
- 12.4 Technical Officials shall be compensated in compliance with norms.
- 12.5 Host Organization shall arrange necessary logistics, including food, snacks, water and etc., to the Technical Officials, as per the norms.

## 13. SCHEDULING OF MATCHES & PLAYERS REPORTING

- 13.1 The **First match** on all the tournament days shall start at **8:00 AM**. (Players to report at 7:30 AM)
- 13.2 The **Last match** for the day shall be scheduled at/around **8:00 PM** in the evening, except finals.
- 13.2 All Players shall report to **Match Control** with readiness, **45** minutes prior to their scheduled time in the Draw. Failure to report so, **may result in No Show + walkover (w.o) without refund.**
- 13.3 In an unlikely event of unexpected delay for whatsoever reason, the same shall be communicated to the **Match Control/Tournament Referee** with the new estimated time of reporting. **Failure to report so, may result in No Show + walkover (w.o.) without refund.**
- 13.5 All Players/Parents/Coaches shall be available to play, if we are running **ahead** of the scheduled time in the Draw. The same applies for any transient **delays** as well.
- 13.6 Rest-Time (**30** mins) shall be given to players, if they are playing more than one (1) event.
- 13.4 → Walkover (**W.O**) time is **NOT AFTER 30** mins from scheduled time, it is **BEFORE 30** mins from scheduled time in the draw. Teams failing to report **BEFORE 30** min of scheduled time, shall be given **W.O**. If both teams are not available, then both will lose resulting in **No Match**.

## 14. GENERAL TOURNAMENT REGULATIONS

- 14.1 The Tournament Referee reserves the rights to cancel any events, with less than **6** entries received.
- 14.2 Proper/Acceptable Badminton attire, including non-marking court shoes must be worn during play.
- 14.3 Athletes must be members in good standing with KDBA at the time of registration.
- 14.4 Players are responsible for providing proof of DOB and attachment to KDBA – on inspection.
- 14.5 Any disputes arising due to doubts in DOB or age or attached district (played/represented in another district) shall be resolved **ONLY** with the Tournament Referee.
- 14.6 Under No Circumstances, a Coach or a Parent-Coach shall demand other players for age proof.
- 14.6 Coaches/Parent-Coaches shall follow guidelines of badminton Coaches Code of Conduct & Ethics.
- 14.7 The Tournament Referee reserves the rights to refuse to allow anyone into the playing arena, due to any dispute created by them.
- 14.8 Any Player found to have proven that they are active/have played in other districts shall be disqualified without prejudice.

## 15. COACHES/PARENT-COACHES CODE OF CONDUCT (BWF Ref. PART III, SECTION 1A, APPENDIX 9, CODE OF CONDUCT FOR COACHES, TEAM AND T.O.)

- 15.1 must not coach when the shuttle is in play or distract the opposing player or disrupt play;

- 15.2 must not verbally abuse or intimidate in any form such as shouting or making gestures, or in any other way distract any spectator, tournament official, technical official, opposing coach, opposing team, or opposing player
- 15.3 must not bring the sport into disrepute through social/media comments, either pre, during, or post tournament that relate to tournament officials, technical officials, opposing coaches or team officials and/or players, that are personal in nature, imply bias, or question their integrity.
- 15.4 must not make, or attempt to make, any unwelcome, abusive or intimidating physical contact in any way with any spectator, parents, tournament official, technical official, opposing players, and coaches;

**16. PLAYERS CODE OF CONDUCT** (BWF Ref. PART III, SECTION 1A, APPENDIX 4, PLAYERS' CODE OF CONDUCT)

- 16.1 Playing another tournament - Having entered and been accepted into the draw of a KDBA-sanctioned tournament and playing in another Badminton tournament during the same period.
- 16.2 Inappropriate Conduct by any means
- 16.3 Arriving late for a match, resulting in a no-show
- 16.4 Trying to influence the decisions of technical officials by arm, hand, racket gestures, or orally
- 16.5 **Audible obscenity:** Using words commonly known and understood in any language to be profane or indecent and uttered clearly and loudly enough to be heard.
- 16.6 **Visible obscenity:** Making of gestures or signs with the hands and/or racket or shuttle that commonly have an obscene or offensive meaning.
- 16.7 **Abuse of shuttle** - Intentionally hitting a shuttle dangerously or recklessly within or out of the court, hitting a shuttle with negligent disregard for the consequences, or deliberately damaging a shuttle or deliberately tampering with the shuttle to affect its flight or speed.
- 16.8 **Abuse of racket or equipment** - Intentionally and violently destroying or damaging rackets or other equipment, or intentionally and violently hitting the net, court, umpire's chair or other fixtures during a match.
- 16.9 **Oral abuse** - Making a statement within the precincts of the tournament site, directed at an official, opponent, spectator or other person that implies dishonesty or is derogatory, insulting or otherwise abusive
- 16.10 **Conduct contrary to the integrity of the game** - Engaging in conduct contrary to the integrity of the game of Badminton. In addition, if a player has at any time behaved in a manner severely damaging to the reputation of the sport, that player may be deemed by virtue of such behavior to have engaged in conduct contrary to the integrity of the game of Badminton.

**17. INJURIES & MEDICAL READINESS**

- 17.1 The Organizers shall provide basic first-aid kit for any minor injuries on the court.
- 17.2 The Organizers shall arrange access to a medical officer, as necessary based on the situation.

**18. APPLICABILITY OF BADMINTON LAWS**

- 18.1 All part of Badminton laws shall be applicable under any circumstances.

18.2 Please refer the most recent BWF laws for Service Faults, Common Faults, Warnings, Line-Call Overrule, Let, etc.,

### 19. ATTENTION: IMPORTANT POINTS

- 19.1 All the participating players/teams are requested to check their scheduled matches and advised to report at least **45** minutes prior, to Match Control.
- 19.2 The first match of the day will commence at **8.00 AM** on all courts, during the tournament days.
- 19.3 The finals and prize distribution shall be completed before **8.00 PM** on Sunday, 15th Jan-2017.
- 19.4 The Players may be asked to wear different shirt colors for the finals.

### 20. DIRECTION TO THE ORGANIZING ACADEMY/COURT

- 20.1 0.75 Kms approx. from Chrompet Saravana Stores
- 20.2 Take the Road adjacent to Kalyan Jewelers – opposite to Chrompet Saravana Stores.
- 20.3 Go till dead-end, turn left. Then, go till dead-end, then turn right at 2-wheeler mechanic shop.
- 20.4 Your destination is in 200 meters straight.

We shall be glad to clarify on any of the above matter and assure you to extend our full support and co-operation in smooth and successful conduct of the KDBA District Ranking Tournament.
